

### Tops

- Undershirts and tank tops, if worn, must be worn with another “cover up” shirt. The “cover-up” shirt must not violate dress code rules. T-shirts are permissible.
- Midriffs may not be visible under any circumstance.
- Torn shirts are prohibited.
- No racer-back shirts or off-the-shoulder shirts may be worn.
- Students may not wear see-through items of clothing. Undergarments should not be seen under clothes.
- Students may not wear articles of clothing or display tattoos with words or images that are disruptive to the school environment. This is a partial list of words or images that would be disruptive: alcohol, tobacco, other drugs, guns, other weapons, gang-related materials, obscenity, profanity, and vulgarity. Any material that constitutes a slur against any racial or ethnic group is also not allowed.

### Bottoms

- All pants and shorts must be worn at the waist. No sagging or low riding.
- Pants, shorts and skirts should not be excessively torn. If there are tears on a student's pants, shorts or skirts, the tear must not be above the fingertip length when the student stands up with arms at his/her side.
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be as long as the student's fingertips when the student stands up with arms at his/her side. Students may not wear items of clothing shorter than this, even if they wear stockings or similar garments underneath.

### Outerwear & Accessories

- Outerwear such as long or oversized coats may not be worn in the building.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times.
- Head coverings such as bandanas, sweatbands, caps, scarves or hairnets are not to be worn in the classroom, except for approved religious purposes.
- Chains and spiked accessories are not permissible.
