2016-2017 Standard School Attire Policy

Antioch High School will maintain a professional learning environment. Standard School Attire is an important part of students learning valuable employability skills and to maintain focus on teaching and learning throughout the school year.

SHIRT OPTIONS:

- Colors: Solid White, Blue, Black, or grey
- Style: Polo style/button down with a collar or approved AHS Spirit Wear

Shirts must cover the midriff. If the shirt extends past the fingertip it must be tucked in. Sweaters, vests that are solid white, black or blue may be worn over the SSA polo shirt. Shirt collars must be visible. Jackets and hoodies that are solid white, black, blue, grey, or AHS Spirit Wear are acceptable. Denim, denim-like or plaid jackets, vests, shirts or sheer/see-through/lacy shirts, tops etc. of any kind are not permissible.

Dresses and jumpers must be a solid color of white, black, blue, or khaki and extend to fingertip length. Jumpers must be worn with an SSA polo style shirt or button-down shirt with a collar. No t-shirt or tank-top dresses allowed.

BOTTOM OPTIONS:

- Skirts, shorts, and casual dress pants are allowed.
- Colors: Solid Khaki, Navy or Black
- Skirts and shorts must extend to fingertip length.
- Approved AHS Spirit Gear

Denim jeans, jeggings or denim material in any color are not permitted. All spirit gear with school logo/name are permitted. Tights/Leggings must be a solid color and worn under an appropriate SSA bottom (color, style, and length).

NON-APPROVED SSA:

Jeans/Denim (in any color), hats, torn clothing, inappropriate language/pictures/buttons on clothing, chains attached to the pants, hair picks, bulky or over-sized coats/jackets, bandanas of any kind, hair scarves, bonnets, slippers, sagging pants, sunglasses, hoods worn on the head and any apparel that can be considered gang-related. Other items as identified in District SSA policy or at the discretion of AHS administration.

STUDENT IDENTIFICATION:

- Every student is issued an ID badge at the beginning of the school year.
- The ID badge is a part of SSA and must be in the student's possession at all times while in the building and to attend school activities/events.

CONSEQUENCES:

Disciplinary action will be enforced in accordance with school and district policy.
