Math: 60 minutes

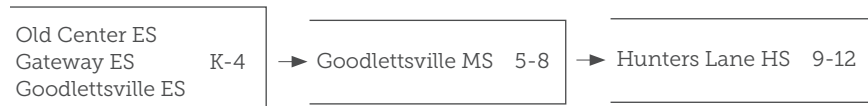
