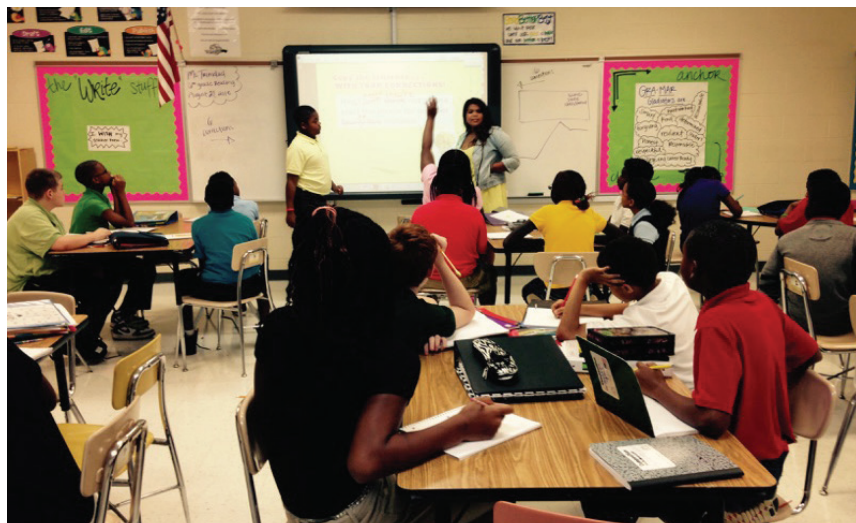

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

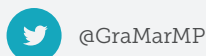
