A TYPICAL DAY AT SCHOOL

Reading (including guided rotations): 120 minutes

Direct English Language Instruction: 60 minutes
(for Active English Language students)

Math: 60 minutes

Lunch: 30 minutes

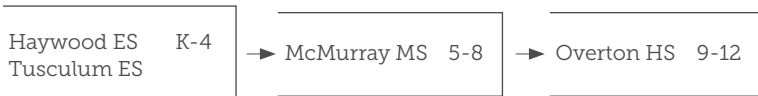
Related Arts: 60 minutes (including two art studios, music, beautiful gardens, a piano lab, and an integrated theatre system in PE)

Intervention or Enrichment: 45 minutes

Kindergarten through first grade (K-1): a minimum of three (3) fifteen-minute periods of non-structured physical activity per day

Second grade through sixth grade (2-6): a minimum of two (2) twenty-minute periods of non-structured physical activity at least four (4) days a week
