

Title I School-Level Parental Involvement Policy

Creswell Middle Prep School of the Arts

Creswell Middle Prep has developed a written Title I parental involvement policy with input from Title I parents. We offer opportunities for parents to give feedback on our parental involvement policy several times a year. The document is sent home semi-annually for parents' review. It is also on our website throughout the year for parents to view and submit changes. Additionally we make the document available at parent meetings for review. The policy describes the means for carrying out the following Title I parental involvement requirements [20 USC 6318 Section 1118(a) – (f) inclusive].

Involvement of Parents in the Title I Program

To involve parents in the Title I program at Creswell Middle Prep, the following practices have been established:

The school convenes an annual meeting to inform parents of Title I students about Title I requirements and about the right of parents to be involved in the Title I program. This meeting takes place every May during our last PTSO meeting of the year. Parents are notified of the meeting via Eblast, marquee, flyers and callouts.

The school offers a flexible number of meetings for Title I parents, such as meetings in the morning or evening. We offer meetings in the early evening before student performances, so that parents can take advantage of already being at the school that day.

The school involves parents of Title I students in an organized, ongoing, and timely way, in the planning, review and improvement of the school's Title I programs through quarterly PTSO meetings. The school involves the parents in the Title I parental involvement policy multiple times a year through PTSO meetings, documents sent home, website review and surveys.

The school provides parents of Title I students with timely information about Title I programs. Parents are given information about the Title I program every spring (May), every fall (August), and also by request anytime.

The school provides parents of Title I students with an explanation of the curriculum used at the school, the assessments used to measure student progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet every year at our annual meeting and open house. Student-led data chats happen on a regular basis throughout the school year.

If requested by parents of Title I students, the school provides opportunities for regular meetings that allow the parents to participate in decisions relation to the education of their children. Meetings can be scheduled through the front office at any time.
