In MATH, we are working on expressions. Please follow the order of operations below to calculate expressions"

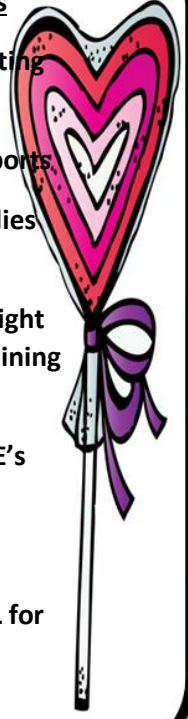
Parentheses
