Second block social studies and lunch: 11 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

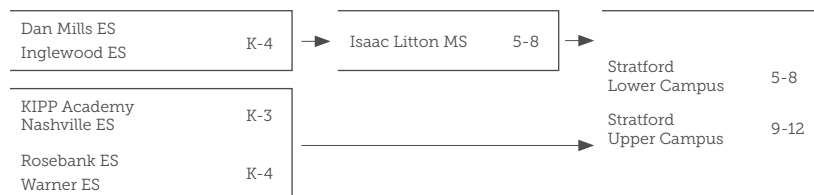
Third block math: 12:30 - 1:30 p.m.
