Our schedule is a rotation ABAB

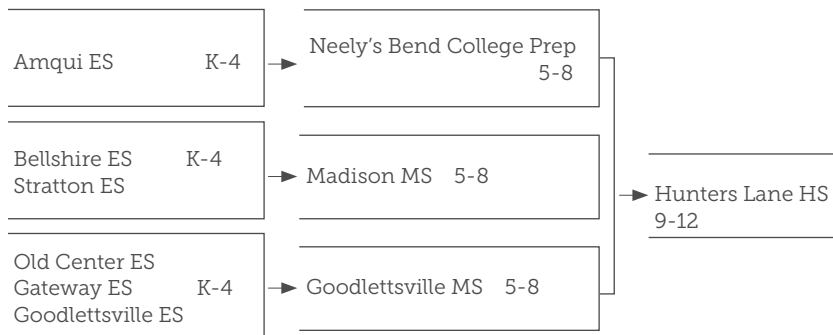
Students can earn eight credits per year on this schedule
