- MCA Tests (Reading/ Math and Science)- Required by State: The rationale for administering this assessment is to assess proficiency of grade level standards
- D.I. Tests- Local Option: The rationale for administering this assessment is because it serves as a tool for knowing if the scholars actually learned the skill they have been taught and if they are able to demonstrate that skill.
