## HOME REBUILDING QUARTERLY REPORT- DEC 15, 2011

OUR HOME REBUILDING PROGRAM CALLED EACHONE BUILDONE IS GOING ON SUCCESSFULLY. EVERY BENEFITTING FAMILY PARTICIPATES IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THEIR OWN NEW HOME PLUS ONE MORE. THOSE SELECTED ARE FAMILIES WHO LOST THEIR HOMES IN THE JAN 12, 2010 EARTHQUAKE.



**Project Account Name:** “EachONE BuildONE” Home Rebuilding

**Actual Date Started:** Three homes funded in December 2011 began construction on December 15, 2011

**Funded by:** Haiti ARISE Ministries Society, our Canada branch, wired a total of **\$23,019.55 US**. \$16,827.45 was spent in Dec and \$6,192.10 was spent in January.

**Status:** Three homes have been finished. General supplies to support the project were also purchased.

**Date of Completion:** January 23, 2012.

**Summary of Activity:** These three homes were constructed for families in the Grand-Goave area. Each family had been living in very bad conditions since the earthquake. Two of the families’ original homes were completely flattened by the earthquake. The third family’s home was severely damaged, but repairable. All three are now living in solid, safe homes. Some of the funding was also used to purchase more general supplies to serve in all of the EachONE BuildONE Home Rebuilding projects.
