



### RECITAL INFORMATION

Our 2<sup>nd</sup> annual recital is fast approaching! We want to provide you with a quick reference sheet that includes the details regarding the event. A few bullet points to keep in mind...

- The Recital is June 23<sup>th</sup> 2018 at the Arden Theatre in St. Albert. It has been divided into 1 solo/duet/trio showcase & 3 shows. Please refer to the schedule that has been emailed to determine which show(s) your dancer(s) will be performing in. We have done our very best to ensure that multiple dances/dancers are performing in the same show, however, we were unable to make this work for every dancer/family. Thank you for your understanding!
- Audience members & dancers watching are required to purchase tickets for each show that they plan to attend. Tickets are \$14.00 + \$1.50 facility fees added by the Arden Theatre. They are available through the box office and ticket master. **Tickets go on sale May 11<sup>th</sup> @ 10am. There is a limit of 6 tickets/family per show until May 21<sup>st</sup> at 10am. The limit will then be taken off at this time.** *Please be aware of the following: Ticket master will add on an extra fee for purchasing online.*
- Level 4 Dancers will have the opportunity to be showcased in more than one recital show. Parents are not expected or required to attend all shows.
- **Dancers must arrive at the Arden Theatre no later than 30 minutes prior to show time in full hair, stage makeup and costume.** Preschool students will be placed in Progress Hall. Older students will be placed in the green room & dressing rooms back stage. Please refer to the schedules posted outside the door to find out which dressing room your dancer will be waiting in.  
**Please note: The Saturday Farmer Market will be running arrive early to ensure enough time to find parking. Parents are not permitted in progress hall or in the change rooms.**
- Please **NO** flash photography. Pictures and videos are permitted as long as there is no flash. Videos of each performance will be on sale in the lobby pre/post shows.

### Make Up Requirements:

**Festival Team (Level I-III)** Please follow the makeup & hair requirements per your costume sheets.

**Future Stars (Preschool-Kinder)** Please follow the makeup & hair requirements per your costume sheets. We understand that not all parents will want to apply makeup to their tiny dancers, however, we encourage blush, mascara and lipstick to ensure that the dancers features stand out on stage.
