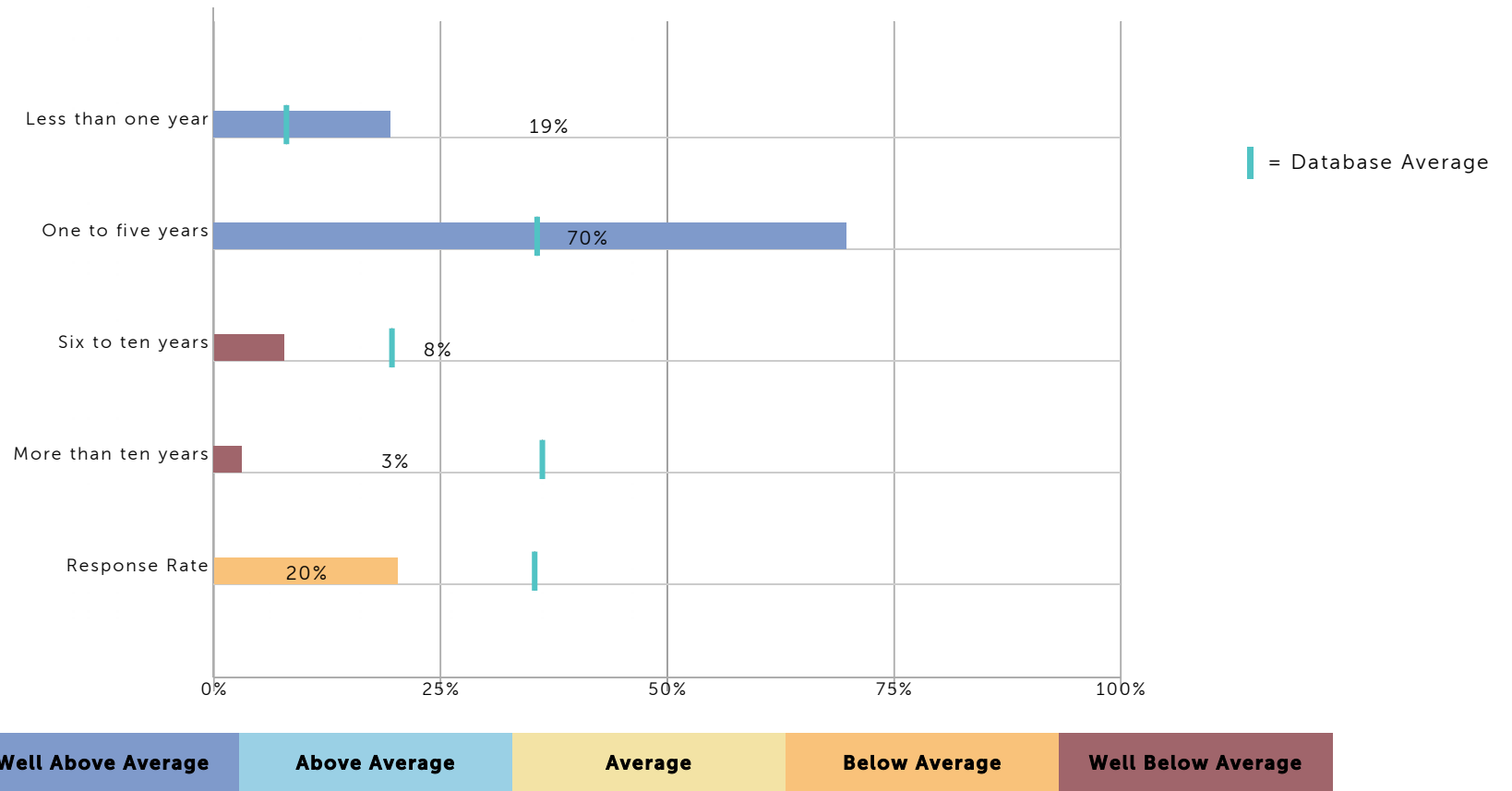

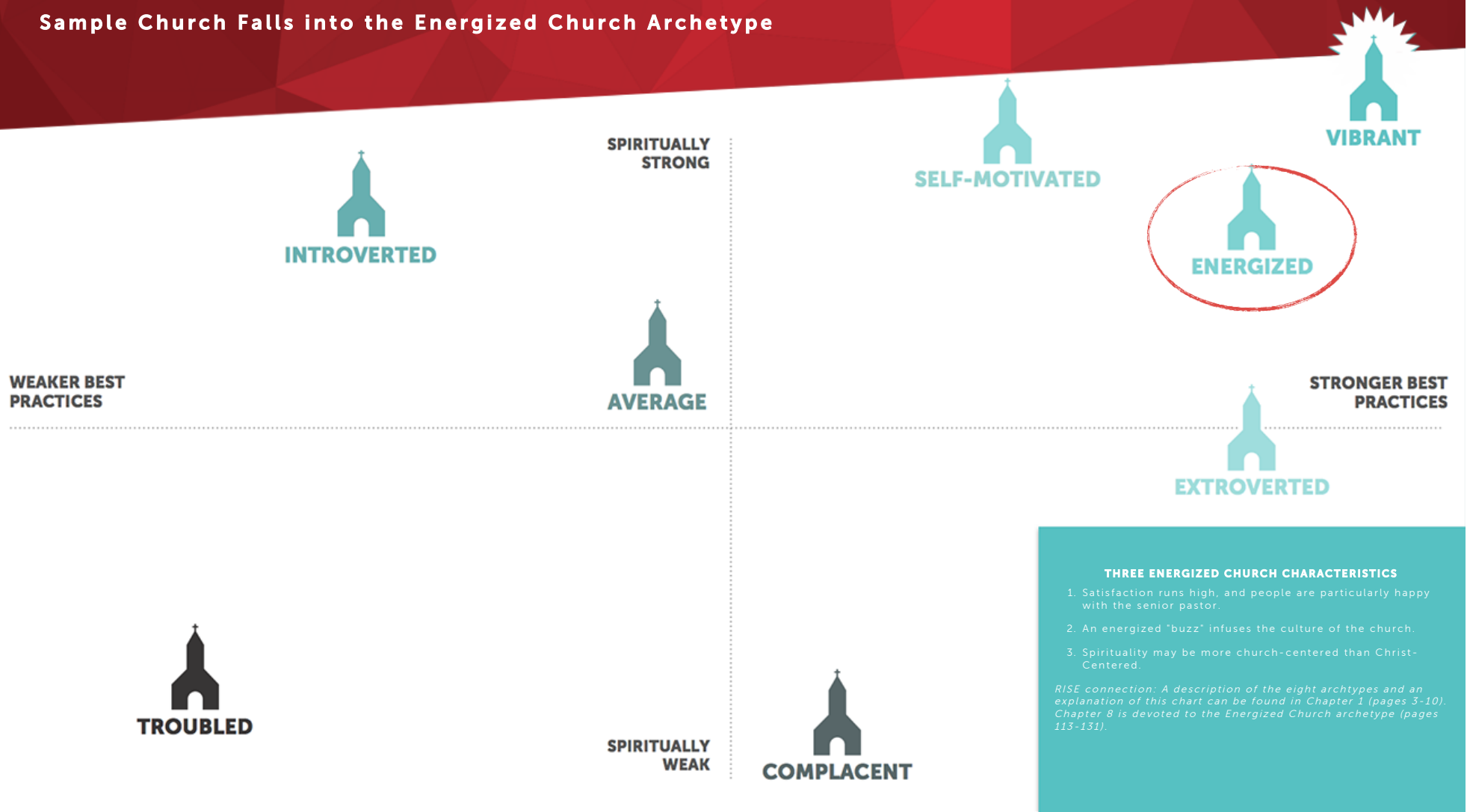

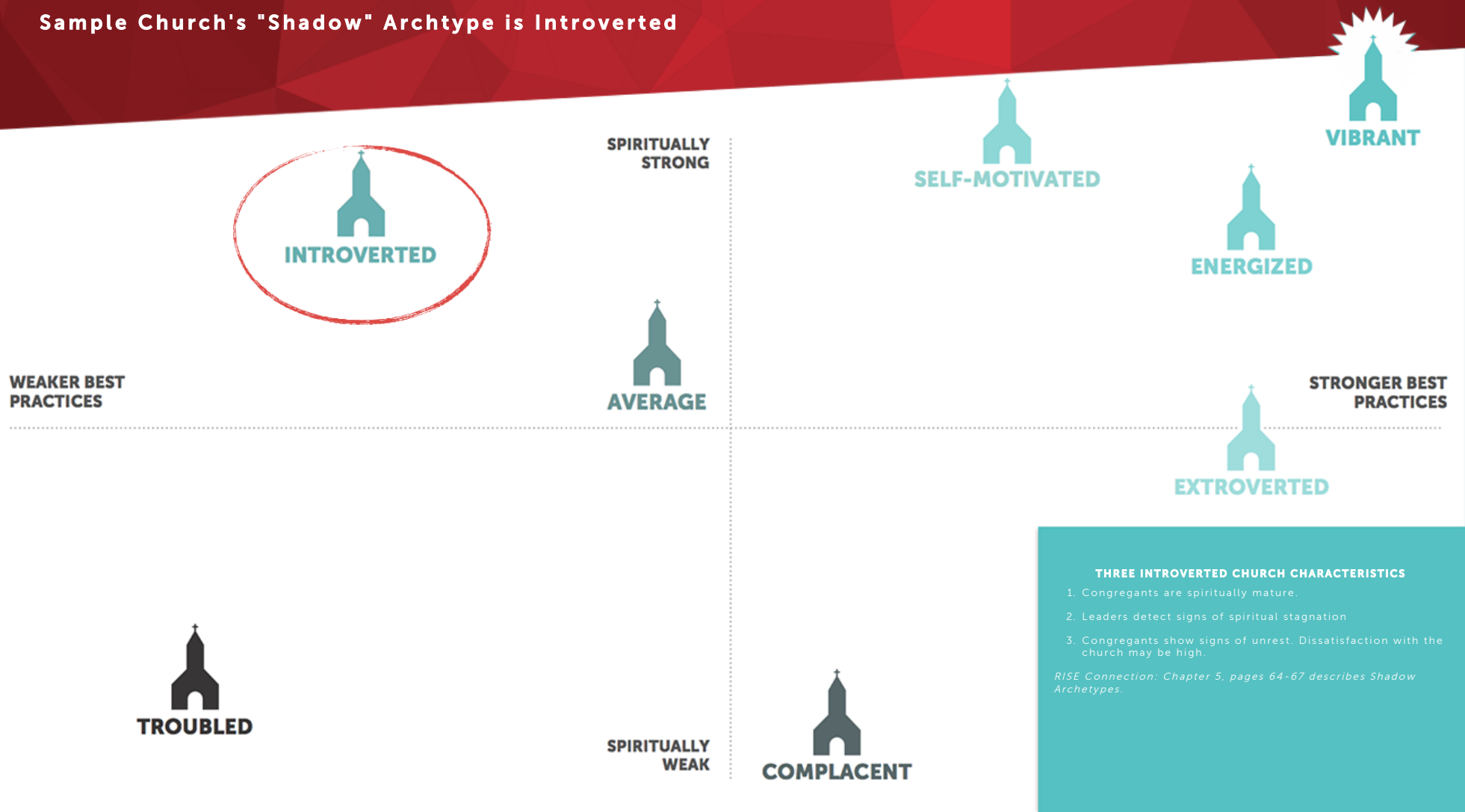

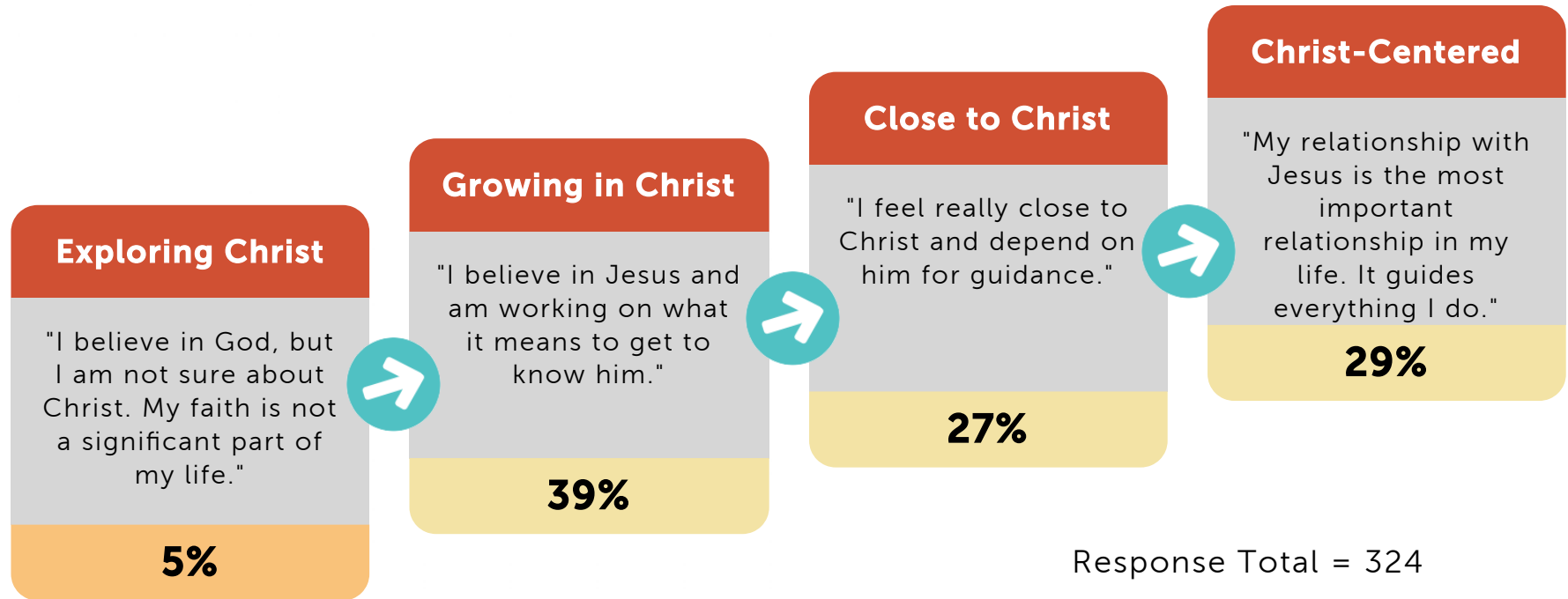


THREE INTROVERTED CHURCH CHARACTERISTICS

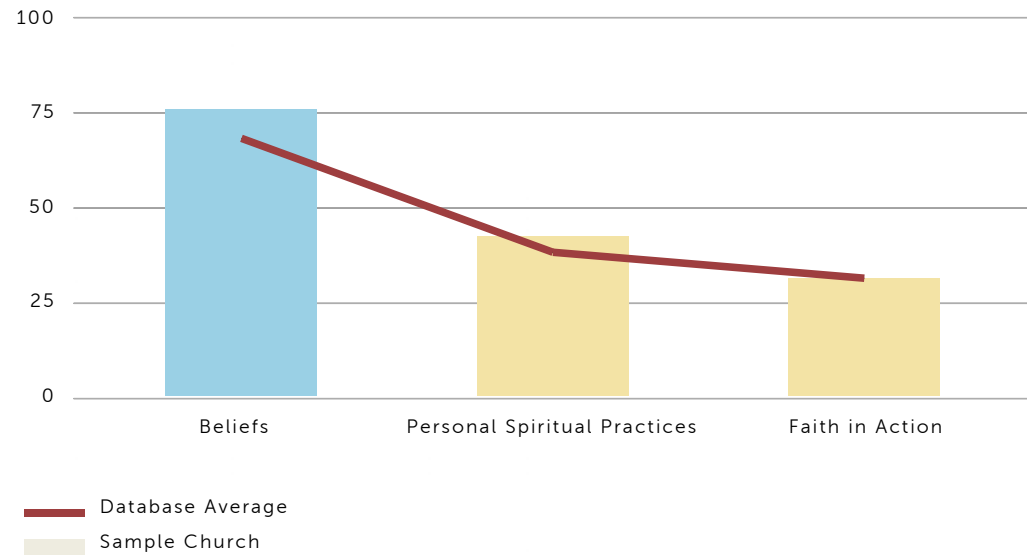
Sample Church's Spiritual Continuum

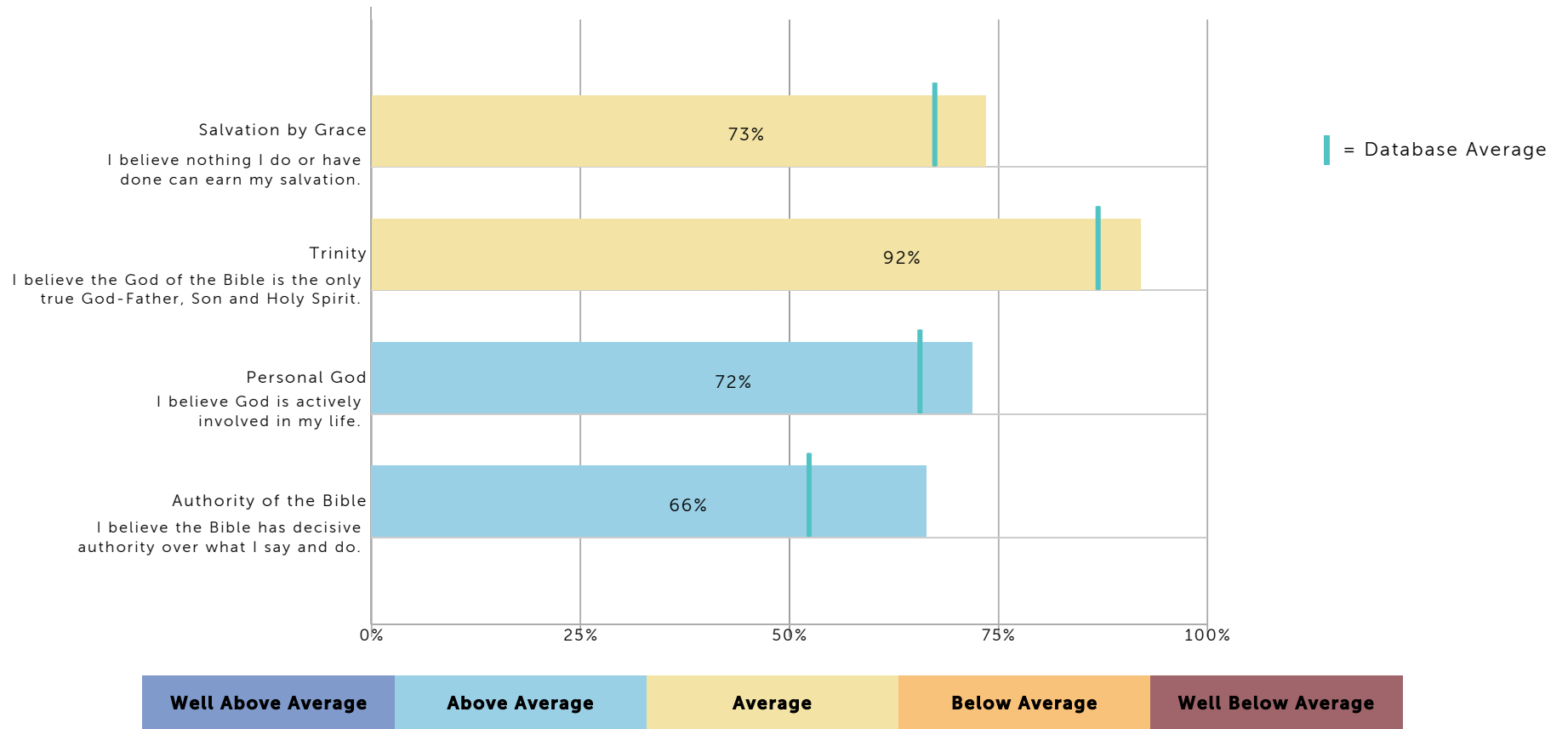

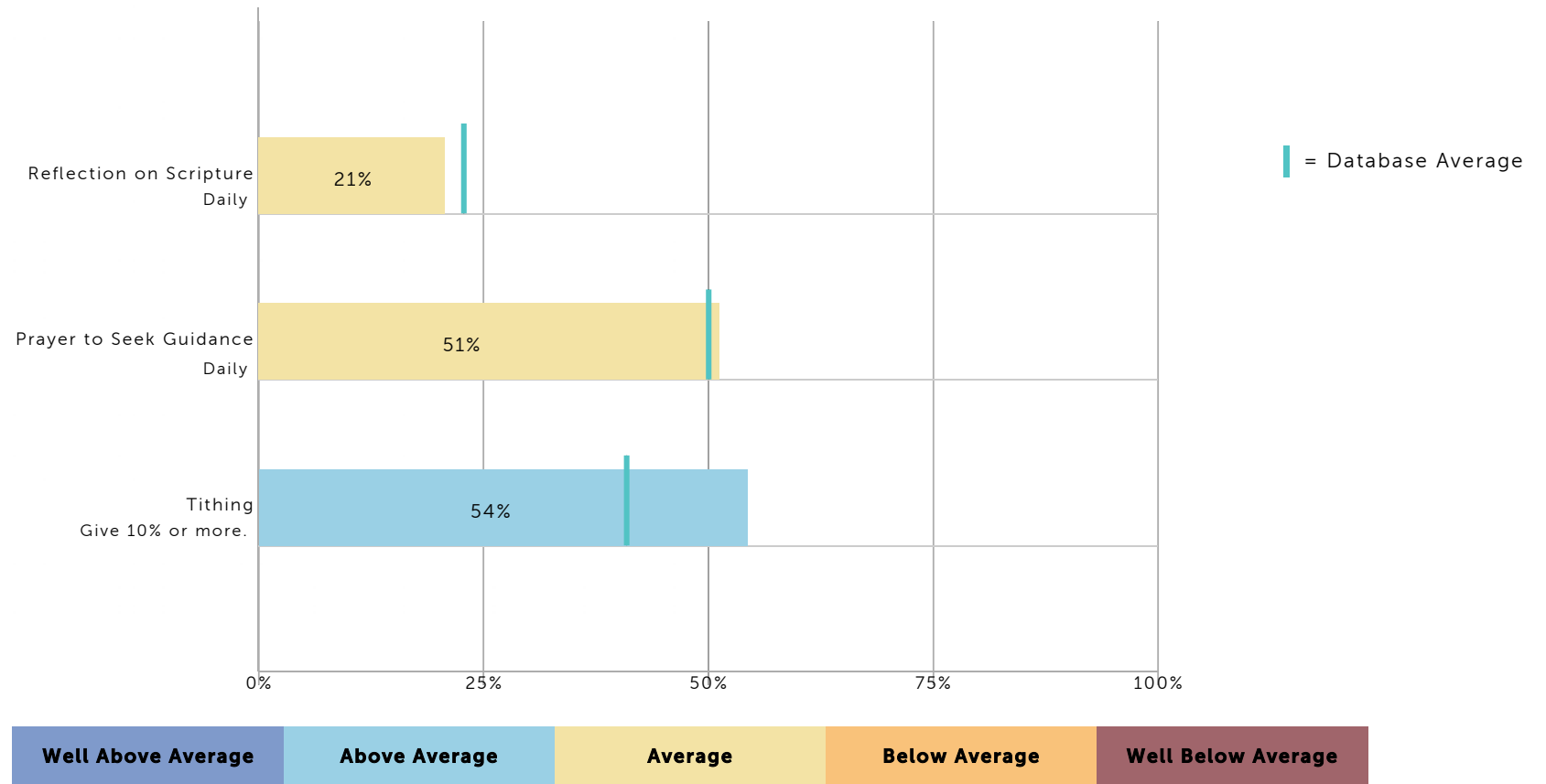

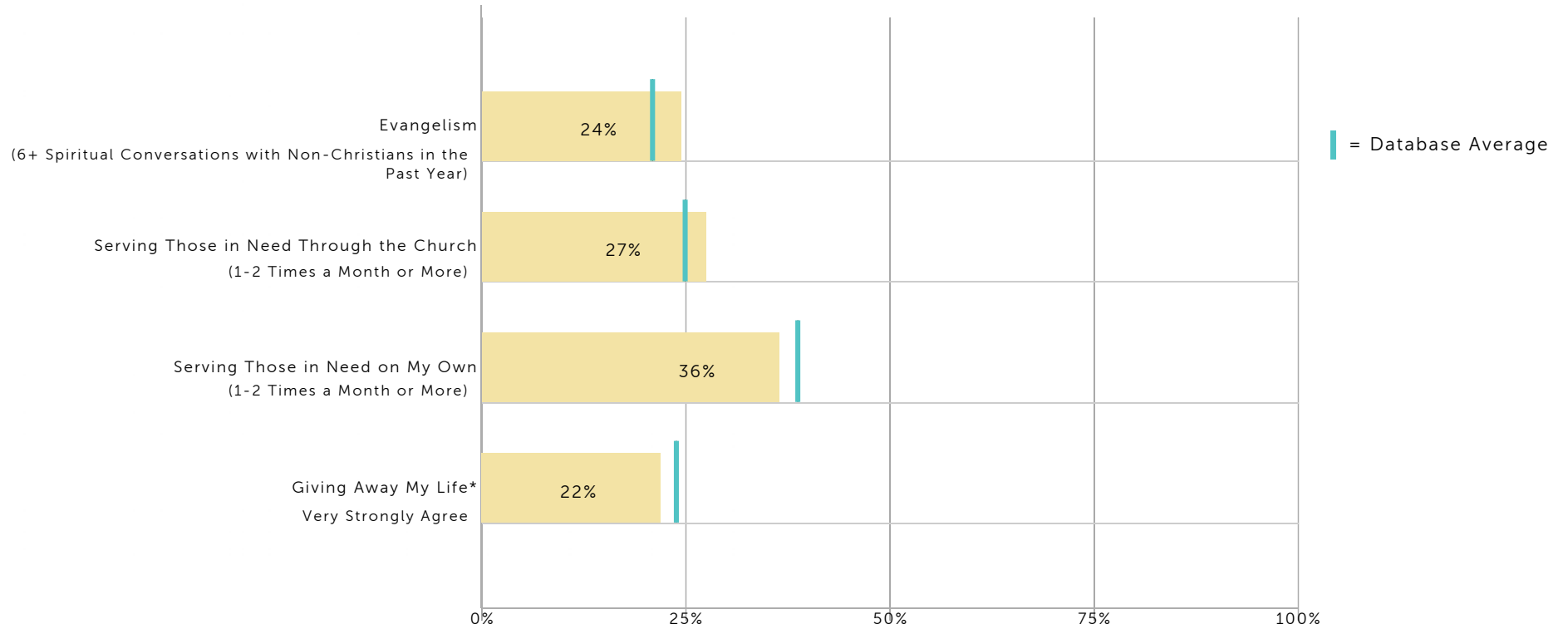

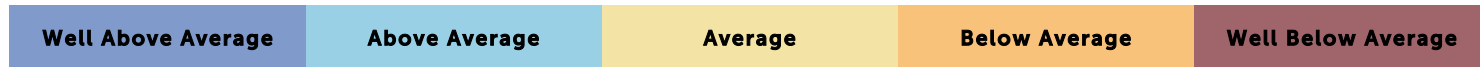

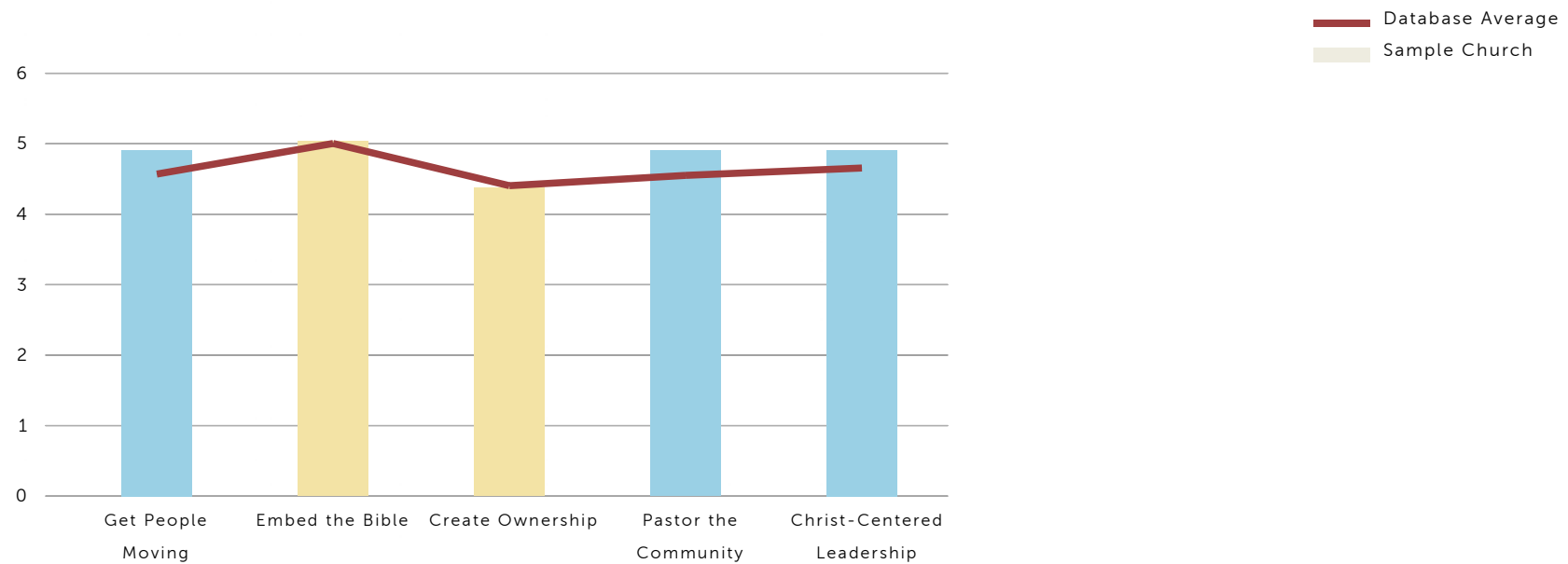

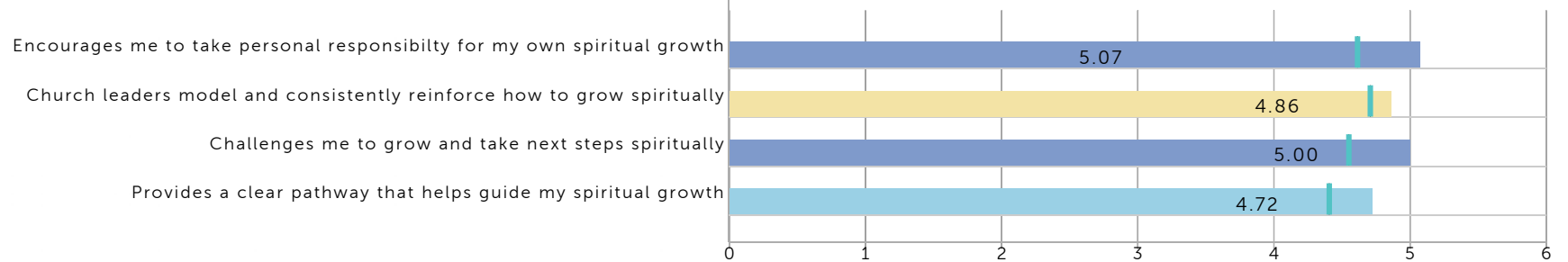

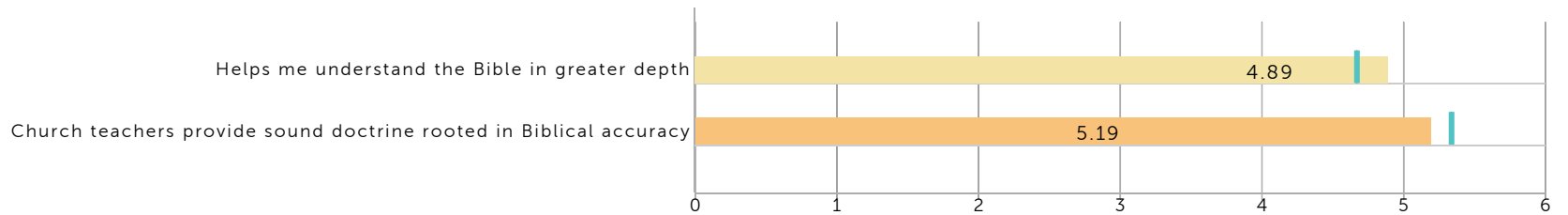

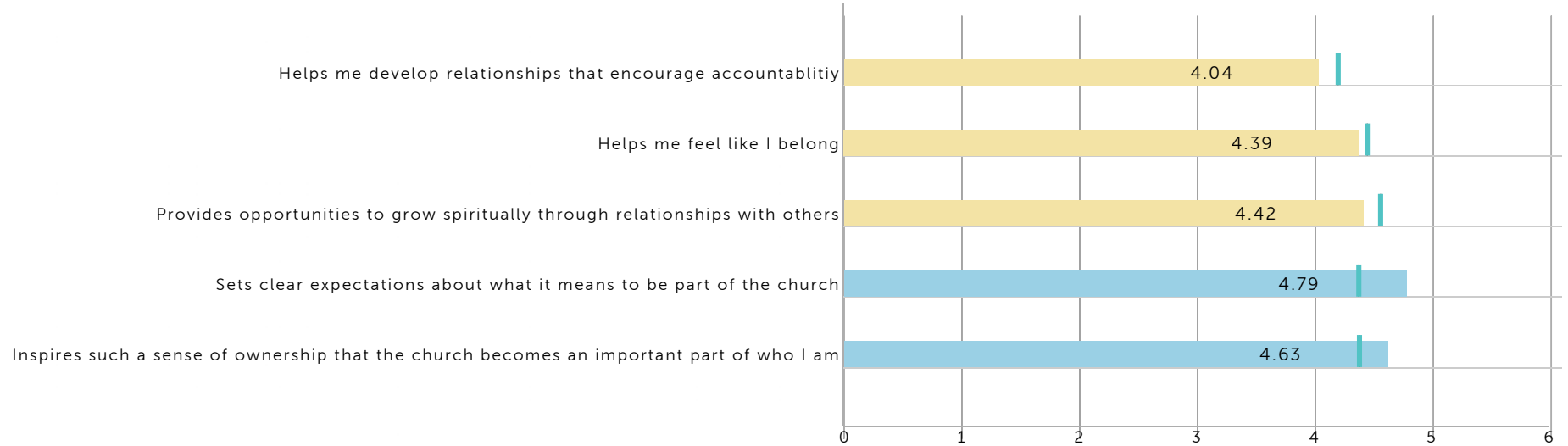

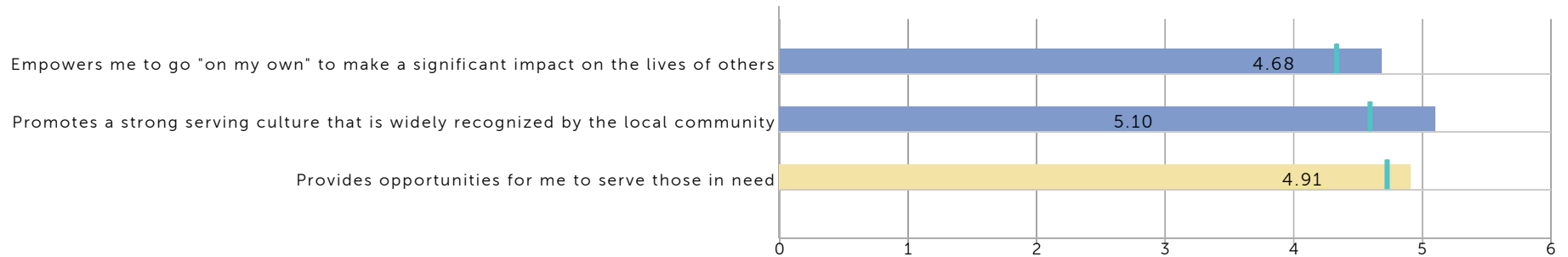

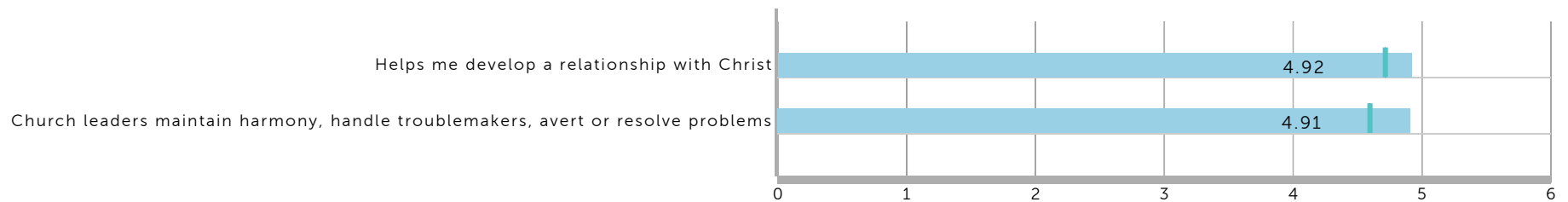

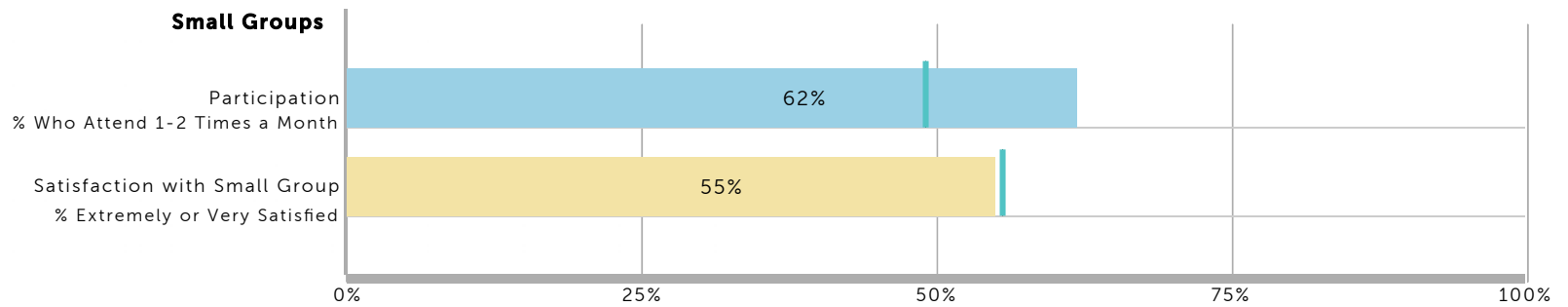
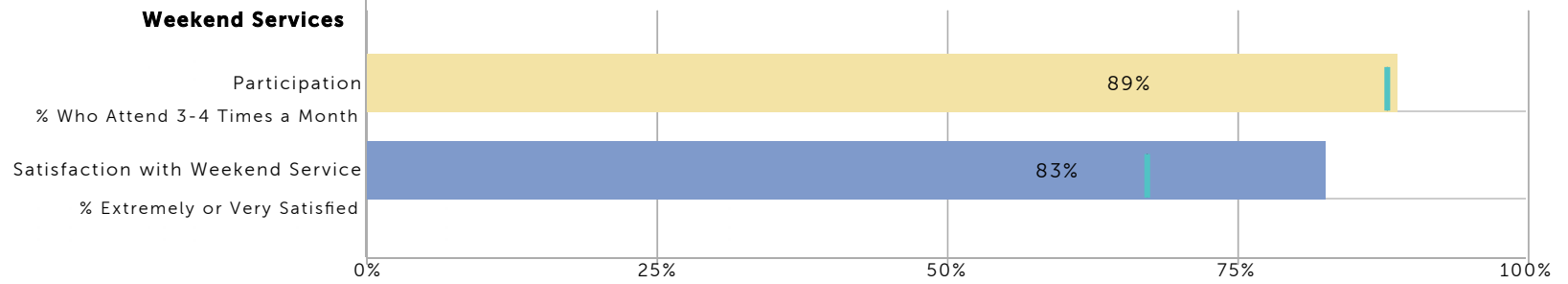

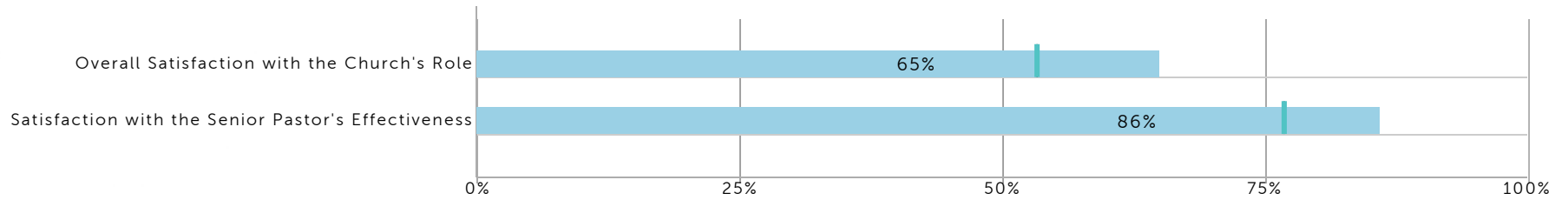

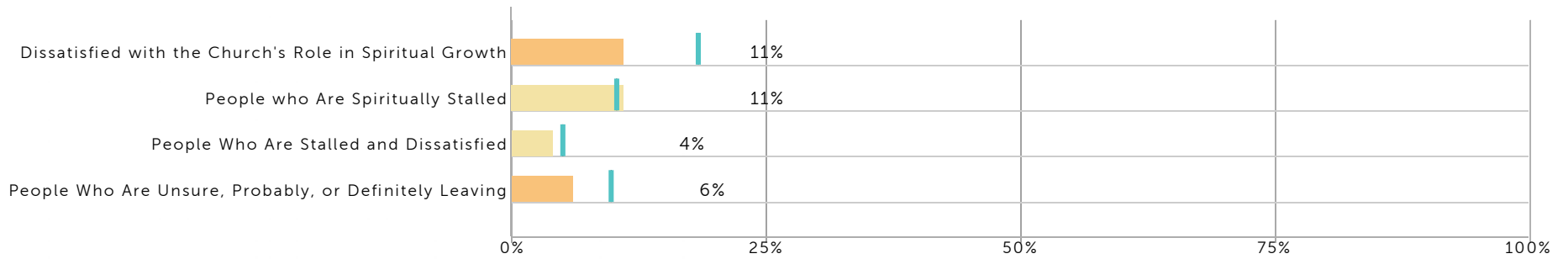
Sample Church's Overall Satisfaction and Barriers to Growth

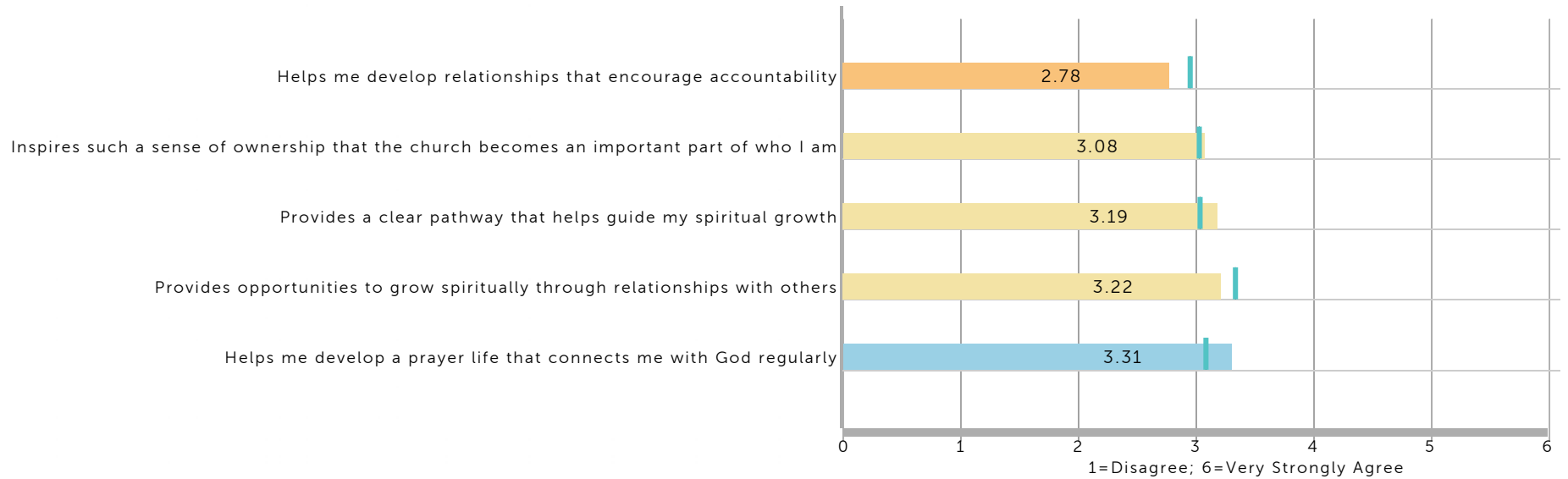
