bring a picture ID and proof of address for all persons  
age 19 and above. For all other children, bring a birth  
certificate, social security card or Medicaid card. One  
month's proof or income for all household members.  
This can be a payroll check or unemployment check  
or letters, social security letters, retirement or other  
income. You can receive food from God's  
Storehouse as often as every 30 days. You can  
receive clothing/household items as often as every 30  
says.
