The school has been given the opportunity to take part in a project that will run jointly between schools and Wiltshire Police. When a child or young person has been affected by a domestic incident, ENCOMPASS will be the system through which the police will report the incident to schools> This will happen by the next school day.

ENCOMPASS will ensure that a member of the school staff, known as a Key Adult, will be shared the information in confidence, whilst ensuring that the school is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have been involved in, affected by or exposed to a domestic abuse incident.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
