School closure due to bad weather

If we have to close the school due to severe weather it would be because:

- Not enough staff can get to school to supervise the children and keep them safe
- Access to the school is dangerous, eg the roads approaching the school and the paths / surfaces in school
- There might be problems with services to the school, such as water and heating

A decision will be made as soon as possible and we will inform Spire FM. We will also text parents and aim to have up-to-date information on the school website. Sometimes we may be able to open later in the morning, so that staff have extra time to get into school. We will do our best to co-ordinate with Durrington Juniors and AVC as to opening times.

If it is icy we will try to grit the path into school and on routes across the playground to classroom doors / main entrance, but be aware that the playground generally and the car park will not be gritted.
