40 Day Prayer Focus

Sunday

"I will cause Your Name to be remembered in all generations. Therefore, nations will praise You forever and ever."

-Psalm 45:17

Ask God to give us a passion for His name and for His glory and that He would mold Cross Community into a multi-ethnic, multi-generational body of believers who have a desire to see the name of Jesus made great in all nations.

Monday

"In Your presence is the fullness of joy, and at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore."

-Psalm 16:11

Ask God to help us, as a church, to find our complete and total satisfaction in Him and that we would desire Him above all else.

Tuesday

"How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, 'How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!'"

-Romans 10:14-15

Ask God to empower Cross Community to be a church that is burdened over the spiritually lost and dying in our world, and that He would embolden us to carry the message of the Gospel locally and globally to those who don't know Him.

Wednesday

"Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen."

Pray that God would do a work through CCC that can only be attributed to His supernatural power and glory. Pray that we would not limit our prayers to what we can manage on our own, but to pray prayers that only He, in His power, can answer. Ask Him to help us exceed every goal of our For His Name effort through these 40 days of prayer and fasting.

Thursday

"Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed fervently that it might not rain, and for three years and six months it did not rain on the earth. Then he prayed again, and heaven gave rain, and the earth bore its fruit."

-James 5:17-18

Pray big, bold, specific prayers for CCC. Pray that God would use our church to draw many to saving faith in Him and that our the work He does here could become a catalyst for spiritual awakening and revival across all of Beaufort, SC.

Friday

"If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind."

Ask God to provide clarity and direction to the leadership of CCC as we continue to seek His desire and His will for the future of our church. Ask Him to give us the boldness to declare the truth of the Gospel without compromise while simultaneously walking in grace and love towards all people.

Saturday

Revisit a prayer focus from Sunday-Friday, and pray for our worship gathering on Sunday morning, that the Gospel would be clear through fellowship, service, communion, song and the Word.
