The Mission of Caritas of Port Chester, Inc. is to provide food, clothing, counseling and education services for anyone in need in Port Chester and the surrounding area. We show respect for the dignity of each individual who seeks our assistance, with the goal of developing personal, economic and social opportunity for all those we serve.

We provide a Community Dining Room, Food Pantry, Open Closet and Emergency Services.

The Community Dining Room in 2015 served 39,496 meals and is presently serving over 110 meals a day. The Community Dining Room is a place where people can find a warm supportive place to come to eat and alleviate their hunger

The Food Pantry served 4,490 households in 2015 and is on track to serve more in 2016. The Open Closet provided clothing for over 5,000 men women and children.

Q & A

What is a Community Dining Room?

A place where a person who is hungry can come and receive food.

Who comes to Community Dining Rooms?

Men, women, elderly and children who do not have food and are in need.

Who comes to a food pantry?

Primarily families with children who are struggling to meet the daily needs of their families. Many are the working poor who just do not earn enough to make ends meet

What are Emergency Services?

These services help to stabilize a person or family in immediate need. They prevent evictions utility termination and provide support for medication assistance when needed.

What is an Open Closet?

The Open Closet provides basic clothing at the change of the season to people who cannot afford to buy new clothing.
