### Exploration, Leadership, & Independence

**The Dan Marino Foundation is offering an exciting opportunity for young adults with disabilities to experience living away from home.**

The Independent Living Program will be held on Nova Southeastern University Davie Campus and Florida International University Modesto A. Maidique campus. Participants will take part in a variety of activities that promote social growth and independence on and off campus.

#### Program Eligibility:

- Young adults with developmental disabilities ages 18 to 28
- Ability to self-administer all medications
- Ability to navigate the community with support at a 1:8 ratio

Young adults will participate in activities focusing on employment, health, personal finance, and leadership. Social activities include art, fitness, cooking, and group recreational activities. Participants will learn time management, meal preparation, and self-care skills.

**Staff will provide 24-hour support and facilitate all activities during the day as well as participant supervision.**
