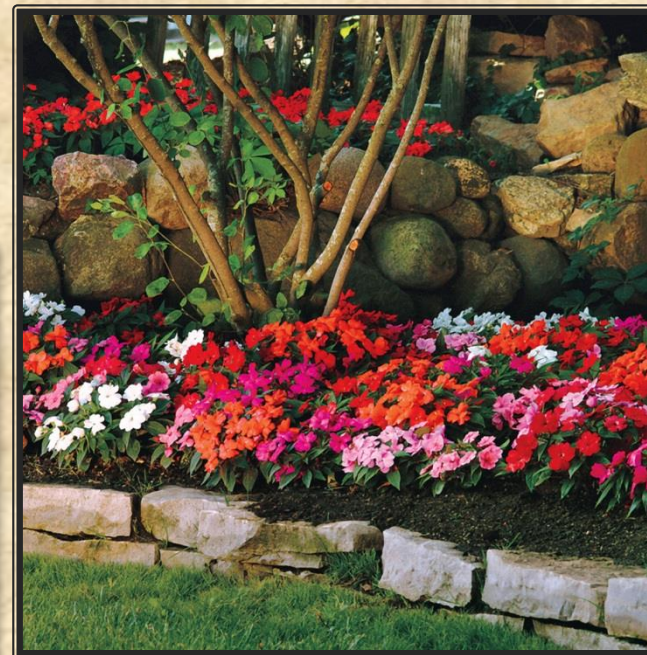

# THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND WHEN SELECTING FLOWERS:

Availability – **Get your selections in early.** There essentially is only one source for all the flowers in Naples. Early selection is key to holding the growing crop for YOU.

Cold Hardiness – **Is your frost protection form signed?** Or do you have a plan in place for protecting your investment in cold weather. Very cold winters are not unusual in Southwest Florida. Cold weather damage is unfortunate and can be prevented. You can also gear your plant choices towards plants that are hardier as the temperatures drop, such as Geraniums and Osteospermum.

Service – **It's not just the flower. It's a process.** Flower installation includes, removal of old flowers, preparation of old ground and addition of new annual soil, Irrigation technician review of coverage and time adjustment. Specialty slow release bloom boosting fertilizer, Pest Control technician spray visit to control fungus, and a 30 day warranty.

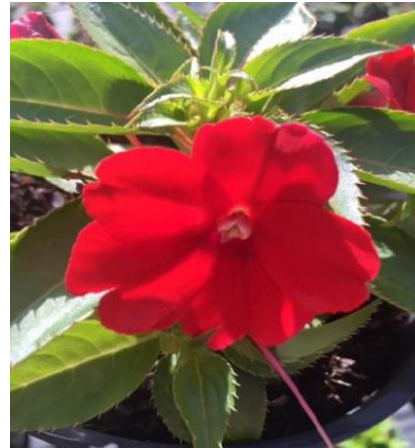

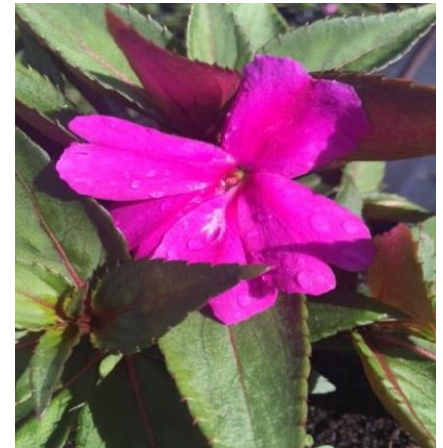

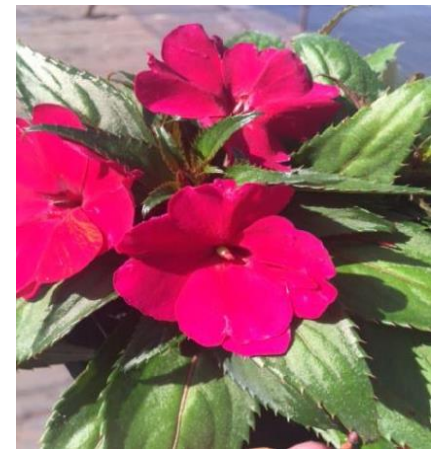

Plant Name	Size	Spacing	Cultural Conditions	Water Requirements	Additional Comments
<i>Begonia semperflorens</i>	8-12"	12" apart	Full sun to partial shade. Full sun plants will be more compact with smaller leaves but still perform well.	Low water once established, more if in sun.	Protect from frost. Bronze leaf variety more heat tolerant. Low salt tolerance.
<i>Begonia x - Angelwing</i>	12-18" x 18" spread	12-15"	Full sun to full shade, takes more sun in winter	Low water requirements once established, more in sun.	Perform well in cool conditions too.
<i>Geranium</i>	8-12"	8-12"	Full sun lovers, geraniums don't do well in partial or full shade	drought tolerant prefers moist well drained soil	Note: Dead heading required; Adding a complete fertilizer as well as an iron application will greatly improve geranium garden performance.
<i>Impatiens Guinea</i> <span style="float: right;">New</span>	12-18"	12-18" mounding 12" OC	Medium shade to full sun. Excellent shade color	High in sun, medium in shade	Notes: Very sensitive to the lightest frost. Medium salt tolerance. Prone to slugs and fungus.
<i>Impatiens Sunstanding</i>	12-18"	12-18" mounding, 12" OC	Full Sun to partial shade	Medium to high in sun, medium in part shade	Robust, sun- and heat-loving Impatiens thrive in full sun or part shade. Huge range of colors that bloom from spring through frost. Unaffected by downy mildew.
<i>Petunia</i>	12-14" x 14-16"	12"	Full Sun	They don't like to be dry for long periods, but they also don't like wet feet	Tolerant of light frost but not a freeze. Remove faded flower to promote new blooms. Quick to recover after inclement weather.
<i>Salvia</i>	14-18" depending on variety	12-14"	Full sun to partial shade	Tolerant of hot, humid weather	Butterfly and Hummingbird attractant.
<i>Snapdragon</i>	6-10"	8-12" OC	Full sun to partial shade, flowers more in full sun	Snapdragons require a good deal of water and must be irrigated often.	Winter annual in south and central Florida. Tolerant of light frost but not a freeze. Remove faded flower spikes to reduce disease and promote new blooms.
<i>Alyssum</i>	6-9"	8-12"	Partial to full sun	Somewhat drought tolerant	Frost sensitive; fragrant border plant
<i>Bacopa</i>	4-6" H x 12-18" W	12-18"	Full Sun - Morning sun in extreme heat climates	Semi-Moist	Non-hardy below 32°F. Great for beds and borders & containers
<i>Dusty Miller</i>	10-12"	9-12"	Full sun to partial shade	Moist, well drained soil	Salt tolerant
<i>Euryops, Bush Daisy</i>	14-18"	12"	Full sun to part sun	Twice weekly	Everblooming
<i>Evolvulus, Blue Daze</i>	Ground Cover	12-18"	Full sun to medium shade	Adequate water until established, then keep on the dry side.	Frost tolerant, wind tolerant, salt tolerant; butterfly attractant.
<i>Scaevola</i>	10-12"	10-12"	Full Sun, 8+hours per day	Drought tolerant prefers moist well drained soil.	Great in baskets or mixed containers.
