ARTIST ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS & AGREEMENT

Only one piece per artist entry

•

All pieces presented for display should be professional in appearance, with 2-D work framed and matted as necessary for hanging. Display cases for jewelry are recommended.

If paintings are not gallery wrapped, they must be framed.

•

A completed Entry Form, Release from Liability Form and Entry Fee submitted by the artist.

•

A current Artist Membership level with the Arts on the Coast (AOC).

•

The deadline for art entry and submission is Saturday, 24 June at noon.

•

All artwork placed in the gallery is for sale. If the gallery sells your piece, the commission is 30% of the asking price, so please take this into consideration when providing a final published price.

•

You are also welcome to sell note cards, prints, books, etc. The 30% commission is also applicable to those items as well, so again, please consider the final published price you want.

All pieces may be picked up from the gallery on Monday, 2017 September 11 between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.
