SPM Pilsner is a light gold-colored malt produced from select 2-row spring barley. This delicately flavored malt offers a complex character of flavors exhibiting both strong grain and sweet honey. A staple of any Pilsner, this malt produces clean, bright and crisp flavored beer in both traditional and contemporary styles. Kiln-dried at a low temperature (<90 C) this malt provides enough enzymatic power to be used as a base malt for up to 100% of the grain bill. This malt can stand alone in character to produce a fine, reserved taste which can enhance a brewers hop notes to produce a special and unique color, aroma and flavor experience. Whether you're creating "Pale Lagers" or "Golden Ales" or even looking to strengthen the backbone of a strong pale ale this malt is the right choice for your beer.
