800th Jubilee of the Dominican Order

~ Theologian of the Papal Household ~

Ever since St. Dominic himself, who was the first to hold the office of Master of the Sacred Place, a Friar Preacher has served at the Vatican as the Pope's personal theological consultant. As when St. Dominic held the office, his duties included expounding upon the Epistles of St. Paul so as to instruct and edify prelates and the clerical attendants of cardinals. These exegetical lectures began what would become the Vatican's school of theology, over which the Master of the Sacred Palace presided.

As the role of the office developed over the centuries, other functions included scrutinizing any sermon to be preached before the Pope, approving anyone to be made a doctor of theology in Rome and authorizing any book to be published in Rome or in its province.

Today, the official title is Theologian of the Papal Household, and Father Wojciech Giertych, O.P., holds the post. He reviews any speech the Pope is to give other than those the Pope himself writes. Father Giertych explains, "The Holy See for centuries has always wanted to have a Dominican in this post. This is a sign of respect for St. Thomas Aquinas and an appreciation of the clarity of his thought. It is the Holy See's experience that it is useful to have somebody at hand who would know Aquinas well and who could help in the process of the formulation of the final text of the papal discourses."
