800th Jubilee of the Dominican Order

~ Reginald Garrigou-Lagrange, O.P. ~

Reginald Garrigou-Lagrange (1877-1964), French Dominican, was one of the most influential theologians before the Second Vatican Council. He joined the faculty of Rome's Pontifical University of St. Thomas (Angelicum) in 1909 where he eventually held the chair of ascetical-mystical theology and gave a public lecture every Saturday afternoon while school was in session. His lectures attracted large crowds as the years went on. He was a master expositor of the thought of St. Thomas Aquinas and is best known for his two-volume masterpiece of Catholic spirituality, *The Three Ages of the Interior Life*.

He retired from the Angelicum after 50 years of teaching and died on February 15, 1964. Pope Paul VI, upon learning of Father Garrigou-Lagrange's death, issued the following statement: "It is with a heavy heart that we have learned of the death of the venerable Father Garrigou-Lagrange, and it is with profound emotion and great gratitude that, in calling to mind the memory of this illustrious theologian, we offer our prayer to God for the repose of the soul of this faithful servant of the Church and of the Holy See."

He was the author of 28 books and over 600 articles. He directed the doctoral dissertations of many notable students, the most prominent being Father Karol Wojtyla, the future Pope John Paul II.
