~ Priestly Fraternity of St. Dominic ~

Since the beginnings of the Dominican Third Order with the writing of the Rule of the Brothers and Sisters of Penance of Blessed Dominic by the seventh Master General, Munio de Zamora, in 1285, diocesan priests who have been urged by supernatural grace to enroll in the Order of St. Dominic, have professed a rule of perfection suited to their state and added a new reason for pursuing greater perfection before God and the world. While the organization for such priests has changed over the centuries, the reason for diocesan priests to unite themselves closely to the Order of Preachers has remained the same: by profession in the Order, they promise to make their lifestyle subject to a special rule of perfection and become sons of St. Dominic.

The Priestly Fraternity of St. Dominic leaves diocesan priests free for the complete service of their local Church but gives them new spiritual helps from their profession as members of the Dominican Family and sharers in the grace and mission of the Order. Thus, priests of the Priestly Fraternity, such as myself, strive to be imbued with the spirit of St. Dominic so as to be true preachers of the Gospel in the world. It is through our pastoral ministry in our own dioceses, in communion with our bishop and the whole Order of St. Dominic, wherein we find, as priests of St. Dominic, our source of contemplation and apostolic spirit.
