## 800<sup>th</sup> Jubilee of the Dominican Order

~ St. Catherine of Siena ~

Catherine of Siena was a Dominican penitential woman who belonged to an association of the laity which over the centuries has evolved into the present-day Dominican Laity. About Catherine, the late English Dominican Kenelm Foster said: "It is at once paradoxical and strangely appropriate that the Order that is doctrinal par excellence, whose motto is Truth and special concern is theology, should have some to see in this young and unlettered woman so authentic a representative of what it essentially stands for." Doctor of the Church, mystic, itinerant preacher, letter-writer, adviser to Popes and crowned heads, Catherine was influential in the return of Pope Gregory XI to Rome after a papal sojourn in France of almost 70 years.

Around the age of 20 she left the confines of her family home in Siena and delved into charitable work, peace-making and the salvation of souls. Gathered around her was a remarkable "community" of young people drawn from noble and influential Sieneese families but also priests of various religious orders. Although an illiterate for most of her life, she began dictating letters to Popes, kings, mercenaries, prostitutes, monks and nuns, and even someone with same-sex attraction. Towards the end of her short life, she dictated a "book" known today as the Dialogue which is a marvelous compendium of her mystical thought.
