

CCD REGISTRATION WEEKEND

K-12 CCD Registration

Forms will be online and in the parish office beginning August 17. Please note: if you will be enrolling any of your children for sacramental preparation, there will be an important folder for you to pick up in addition to the registration forms. The folders, blue for First Holy Communion and red for Confirmation, include sacramental forms to be submitted at registration, as well as verification of baptism. They will be available in Siena Hall the weekend of registration, and in the parish office beginning August 31. Teachers for these two classes will be available on the weekend of CCD registration, August 29 and 30, after the Saturday Vigil Mass and all the Masses on Sunday to assist with registration and distribute folders. They will also be glad to answer any questions you may have about this coming year, or any other aspect of our parish CCD program.

Classes begin Monday, September 21. Our high school classes, which include Confirmation preparation for ninth and tenth graders, begins on Sunday, September 27.
