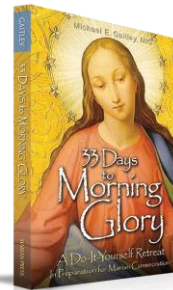

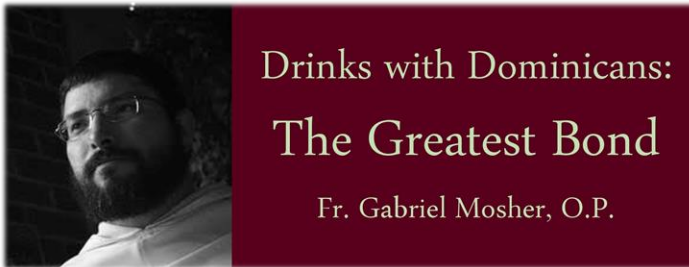
ROSARY BOWL NW INVITES YOU TO: 33 Days to Morning Glory Retreat: A Marian Consecration

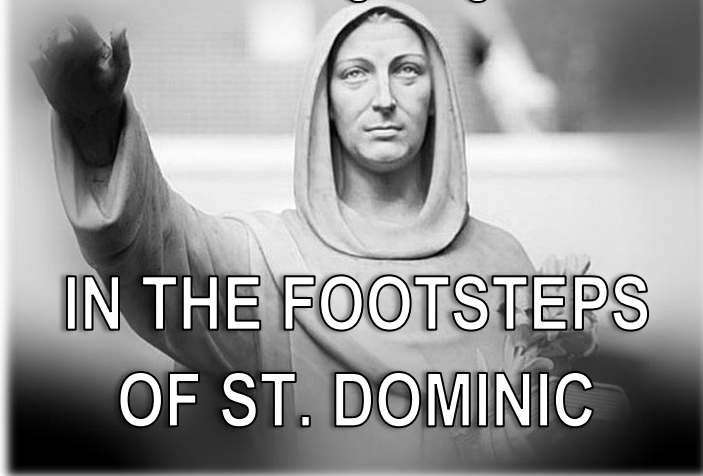
