Natural Family Planning Awareness Week is a national educational campaign. The dates of Natural Family Planning Awareness (NFP) Week highlight the anniversary of the papal encyclical *Humanae Vitae* (July 25) which articulates Catholic beliefs about human sexuality, conjugal love and responsible parenthood.
