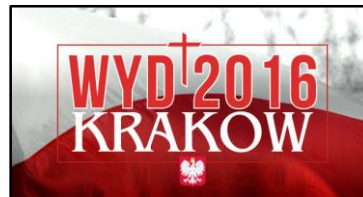

MEMORIAL DAY REQUIEM MASS

On Memorial day, Monday, May 25, at 7:30 PM, Fr. Vincent Kelber will celebrate a Requiem Mass according to the Dominican Rite. Cantores in Ecclesia will sing Duarte Lobo's *Missa pro Defunctis, 8 vocum* (1621). Other music will include the motet *Versa est in luctum* by Alonso Lobo and Victoria's setting of the responsory *Libera me, Domine*. At this Mass, we pray for our beloved dead much in the same way we do on All Souls Day.

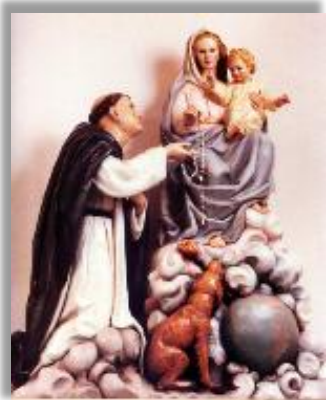
