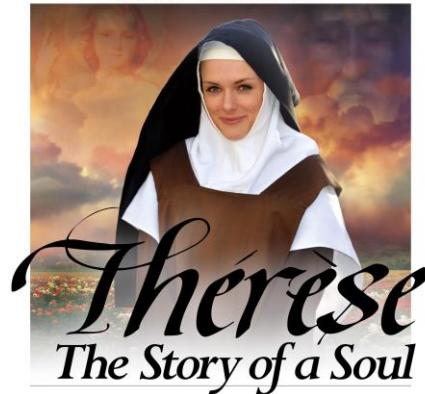

It's official! Holy Rosary is forming a group to participate in the archdiocesan pilgrimage to World Youth Day 2016 in Krakow, Poland.

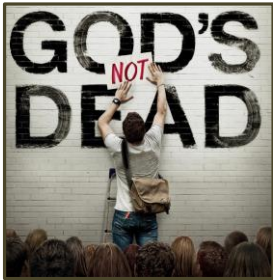
