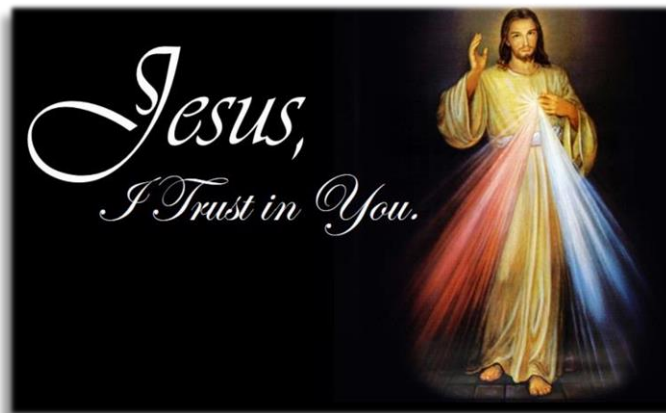

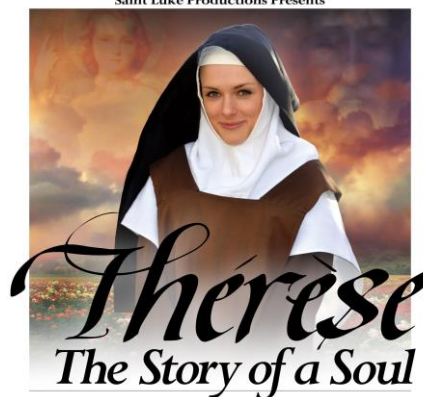

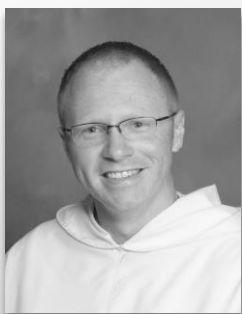
## FEAST OF ST. CATHERINE OF SIENA
