Mark Padrez, our Prior Provincial, and other familiar faces, like Fr. Francis Le and Br. Chris Brannan.

He will step down as prior on April 20 and we will conduct an election of a new prior following a Mass of the Holy Spirit at noon on April 27.

Yes, "brother," as he will be ordained to the priesthood at the end of May. This will be the soon-to-be Fr. Gabriel's first assignment. I find Br. Gabriel to be an energetic Dominican friar, zealous for upholding orthodoxy and tradition.
