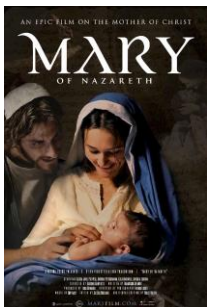

SEMINAR ON THE HEALING OF FAMILIES

Many Catholics have read "The Healing of Families: How to Pray Effectively for Those Stubborn Personal and Familial Problems," by Fr. Yozefu B. Ssemakula. During the month of February, Fr. Hopefully, through our study we can deepen our appreciation for the rich treasure that is the Liturgy has to offer, and to worship with greater attentiveness in the future.
