TEACHING MASS

Fr. Vincent invites all interested to a Teaching Mass on February 24, 2015 at 7:30 PM in the Church. It will be a "Dry Mass," in that the Eucharist will not actually be consecrated. This will provide for the opportunity to explain the Mass more slowly and to field questions about the Sacred Liturgy. Fr. Vincent will walk through the Mass, explaining its details, rituals, and symbols. The Teaching Mass is open to all, whether your knowledge of the Liturgy is great or small. For the most part, Fr. Vincent will speak about the Ordinary Form (post-Vatican II) Mass only, but mention will be made of other Rites of the Church in as much as they help us understand the Mass we commonly celebrate. Hopefully, through our study we can deepen our appreciation for the rich treasures that is the Liturgy has to offer and to worship with greater attentiveness in the future.

SEMINAR ON THE HEALING OF FAMILIES

Many Catholics have read “The Healing of Families: How to Pray Effectively for Those Stubborn Personal and Familial Problems,” by Fr. Yozefu B. Ssemakula. During the month of February, Fr.
