The early Church Fathers, being very sensitive to how Sacred Scripture speaks of Jesus, see that in His short life, Jesus recapitulated the life of the Hebrew people in the Old Testament period. Since we are called as Christians to follow Christ and His life by the grace of the Sacraments, we must live according to the pattern of His life. And that pattern is the pattern of the Hebrew people. We will explore what this means for us today.
