### ROSARY DOMINICAN STUDENT APPEAL

On the weekend of October 4 - 5, we will have our annual appeal on behalf of our Dominican student brothers and novices. Our residency student, Br. Andrew Dominic Yang, O.P., will speak at all the Masses. This is the one time each year that we ask for your support of our brothers in formation. We do not receive any financial help from the diocese, so please be generous in supporting the formation of our future Dominican priests.

*Dear Brothers and Sisters,*

*This week continues our discussion:*

The Master of the Order is elected once every nine years by the priors provincial and representatives from the various provinces. According to the Constitutions of the Friars Preachers, the Master of the Order, "is the successor of St. Dominic and the principle of the Order's unity, is the proper and immediate prelate of all the brethren, convents, and provinces, in virtue of the profession of obedience made to him by every member." (LCO, 396) The Master of the Order then (currently the Most Rev. Bruno Cadoré, O.P., 86th successor of St. Dominic) has for his term of office the power of a bishop of all the friars of the Order. Our Prior Provincials also share in that power, but only in the regions where they govern.

In the case of the Province of the Most Holy Name of Jesus, that region is the ten Western U.S. States. Like the Master of the Order, the Prior Provincial is elected by representatives from the Province, the sitting priors of local communities and elected delegates from the various regions of the Province. His term is only four years, but unlike the Master of the Order he may be elected for a second term. Priors, like our own Very Rev. Stephen Maria Lopez, O.P. are the local superiors of our larger local communities. A prior is elected for three years, with the possibility of a second term. I was appointed by the Provincial last year to be care for the Holy Rosary Church, but Fr. Stephen is the "Father Superior" of the eight friars living in the priory. Within the priory, I am also the subprior. As subprior I assist Fr. Stephen in the governance of the priory and keep charge when he is away. This coming January there is an elective chapter for our Prior Provincial in Oakland. As prior of Holy Rosary, Fr. Stephen Maria is an ex officio member of the chapter. It turns out that I was selected also a representative from this region to cast a vote. I will share more on our trip to Oakland as it approaches.

Please keep your local, provincial, and international Dominican Friars in prayer. May we continue to live zealously for Christ and like our founder St. Dominican preach his Holy Name always.
