RELIQUARIES

Holy Rosary Church possesses a number of sacred relics. On certain feast days some are brought out for veneration by the faithful. The most common of these are those of the Holy Cross, St. Dominic, and the Veil of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is possible because these particular relics are contained in reliquaries made for the veneration of the faithful at the altar rail. Recently more relics have been offered to the parish, under the condition that the relics will be venerated publicly. With these additions, our relics may include the crown of thorns, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Vincent Ferrer, St. Pius X, St. Therese, St. Vincent de Paul, St. Rita, and others). As of yet these relics have no reliquaries and remain for the most part hidden. If you are interested in helping fund worthy housing for the Saints of God please consider making a donation.
