800th Jubilee of the Dominican Order

~ Founding of the Province of the Holy Name ~

In 1850 Archbishop Joseph Sadoc Alemany, O.P., was appointed bishop of the two Californias, Alta and Baja, Nevada, most of Utah and a fair slice of Arizona, with his episcopal see in Monterey. On the night of Friday, December 6, 1850 he arrived in California with another Dominican friar, Fr. Francis Sadoc Vilarrasa, O.P. and a Dominican sister, the Belgian-born Sr. Mary Goemaere. Abp. Alemany with his party was formally welcomed and the following day, December 8, and he presided at the Mass of the Immaculate Conception in the small wooden church of St. Francis, the only Catholic church in San Francisco besides the mission. After the Mass he was presented with a gift of \$1400 to cover the expenses projected for the visitation of his vast diocese.

Fr. Vilarrasa under the title of “commissary general” became the founder of the Province of the Holy Name, though it is to Abp. Alemany that the idea and inspiration of the province originally belong. Even before he was consecrated bishop, as the newly appointed provincial of the Eastern Province he had begun the process. Originally from the Dominican Province of Aragon, Fr. Vilarrasa faithful served as the superior of the Dominicans in California until his death in 1888. Abp. Alemany died later that same year.
