## 800<sup>th</sup> Jubilee of the Dominican Order

~ Ecole Biblique ~

The Ecole Biblique (French for "Bible School"), officially the Ecole biblique et archeologique francaise de Jerusalem, is an academic establishment in Jerusalem, founded and administered by the Dominican Order, and specializing in archaeology and Biblical exegesis. The school was founded in 1890 by Marie-Joseph Lagrange, a Dominican priest.

The school is situated close to an ancient church to which the supposed relics of St. Stephen were transferred in 439. Since its creation, the school has been involved in the exegesis of biblical texts and has carried out archaeological research, in a complementary manner, in Palestine and the adjacent territories. Its principal disciplines are epigraphy, the Semitic languages, Assyriology, Egyptology, other aspects of ancient history, geography, and ethnography. Following the discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls, the scholars at the school have been heavily involved in the translation and interpretation of the texts.

It is authorized to confer doctorates in Scripture. It publishes the Revue Biblique, which is a diverse collection of scholarship from its fields of excellence, and it also publishes material addressed to larger audiences, including a particular French translation of the Bible, known as the Jerusalem Bible which has been translated to English.
