800th Jubilee of the Dominican Order

~ University of Fribourg ~

The University of Fribourg in Switzerland (near Bern) was founded by the state government in 1889. At the time it was the first Swiss university to have a Catholic faculty of theology. The other universities had Reformed faculties (Basle, Zurich, Bern, Geneva, Lausanne). The faculty was entrusted to the Dominican Order, because the Jesuits, who had good historical reasons to undertake the task (since St. Peter Canisius was buried there) insisted on unacceptable conditions of control.

The faculty has been a center of Thomist study since the beginning. Biblical studies also have played an important role. Liturgical and pastoral studies have also played a role in the formation of the clergy. The faculty has developed an ecumenical institute. Dominican Fathers Stefan Pfuertner and Servais Pinckaers played a role in moral theology. The theological tendency of the faculty has mostly been moderate. Members of the faculty have served on the Pontifical Biblical Commission and on the International Theological Commission. Former faculty members include Cardinal Christoph Schonborn, O.P., archbishop of Vienna and Archbishop Jean-Louis Brugues who is a member of the Vatican curia.
