## 800<sup>th</sup> Jubilee of the Dominican Order

### ~ Nuns in Menlo Park and Hollywood ~

Saint Dominic brought many souls from the life of error and among there were nine noble ladies whom he converted from the Albigensian sect. With them in 1206, he founded the first Dominican monastery of nuns at Prouille, France.

Within the Western Dominican Province there are two monasteries of cloistered nuns, both in California. Our Lady of the Angels is in Hollywood and Corpus Christi is in Menlo Park, not far from the Stanford University. These monasteries are like lamps shining on top of a hill. They live a life of intense prayer for the salvation of the world. In their prayers they carry within their hearts St. Dominic's incessant prayer during his vigils, "Lord, what will become of sinners." The late Archbishop of Los Angeles, Timothy Cardinal Manning, in his letter to the prioress of Our Lady of the Angels wrote: "The presence of the sisters in the Hollywood area is more justified today than even in the past at the time of their first foundation."

The Dominican Nuns live a life hidden with Christ in God. They accompany the whole Dominican Family of Friars, Sisters, and Laity in the Order's preaching mission for the salvation of souls through their silent presence, prayer, contemplation, community life, study, and sacrifice in the heart of the Church within the Western Dominican Province of the Order of Preachers.
