800th Jubilee of the Dominican Order

~ Rose Hawthorne, O.P. ~

Rose Hawthorne was the daughter of famed author Nathaniel Hawthorne. She met and married George Lanthrop, a fellow American, while in Europe, and the two returned to the U.S. to begin their family and careers. Unfortunately, their only child, Francis, died when he was just five. The two found solace for their loss in the friendship of a Catholic couple, which led them to be received into the Church in 1891.

Rose would suffer further tragedy when her husband George, grieved by his failure of his writing dreams, became an alcoholic. Eventually, Rose made the brave decision to seek a formal separation from George. Out of the darkness of the moment, she sought a greater purpose, and so began to care for the poor suffering with cancer in her home. Her money provided food and shelter, her hands bandaged wounds, her mouth spoke words of consolation-but when she realized the mission was bigger than what she could handle alone, Rose called for help. Miss Alice Huber responded, and so began the Dominican Sisters of Hawthorne.

Rose, now called Mother Mary Alphonsa, instilled in her sisters a generous dedication to works of mercy; and she herself tirelessly begged for the financial support needed for the ministry. To this day, the Hawthorne Dominicans provide free medical care to the poor suffering with cancer.
