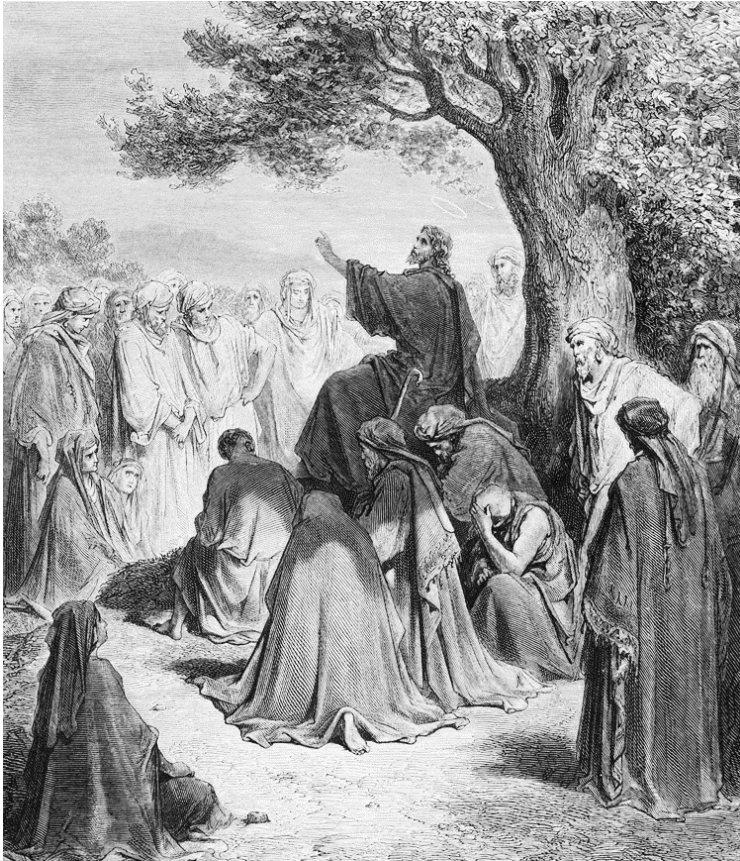

Though not living within our boundaries, the friars of our province are close to two well know congregations of active Dominican Sisters. Traditionally active sisters have worked to educate youth and to care for the poor and sick. These particular congregations work in schools around the nation.

The St. Cecilia Congregation of sisters, called the Nashville Dominicans, was founded in 1860. The sisters while poor in material goods, were “rich in charity,” bequeathing a legacy of humble, prayerful, and energetic virtue. This treasure of the St. Cecilia Dominican life has been carefully safeguarded and passed on from generation to generation. During the period of rapid changes following the Second Vatican Council, the Congregation was gifted with dedicated and capable leadership ensuring continuity with the past and adoption for the present.

The Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist is a community of women religious based in Ann Arbor, Michigan. The community was founded in the Dominican tradition to spread the witness of religious life in accord with Saint John Paul II's vision for a New Evangelization. The congregation has grown in vocations from four founding Sisters to over 120 women religious since 1997 with an average age of only 30 years old. While our Motherhouse is in Ann Arbor, Michigan, their apostolic endeavors frequently bring us to other parts of the United States and beyond.
