800th Jubilee of the Dominican Order

~ House of Studies in Oakland, California ~

The house of studies, or *studium*, is where young Dominican friars receive their philosophical and theological education. The *studium* also serves as the primary place of human and spiritual formation for the young friars. St. Albert Priory in Oakland, California is house of formation for Province of the Most Holy Name in the Western United States. Student brothers attend classes at the nearby Dominican School of Philosophy and Theology in Berkeley, California.

Currently, the Western Province has 22 young friars who have graduated from college and who are now in a seven-year program of studies leading to solemn vows and/or ordination to the priesthood. Including the novitiate year, formation is eight years long. The first three years focus on philosophy and introductory theology courses, then a year is spent in pastoral ministry outside Oakland, and finally three years of theology studies: moral theology, Scripture, systematic theology, spirituality, sacramental theology, pastoral studies, and, of course, preaching.

One of the great features of the stadium is the diversity of the background of men in formation. Engineers, teachers, philosophers, scientists, etc. all find themselves to leave the world and preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Backgrounds vary, but the mission of preaching the Truth of the Gospel for the salvation of souls unites and molds the young friars.

YOUNG MEN’S SCHOLA

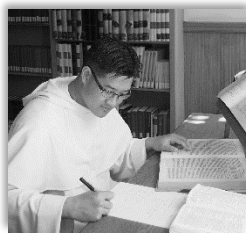

Help Support the Dominican Brothers Studying for the Priesthood!

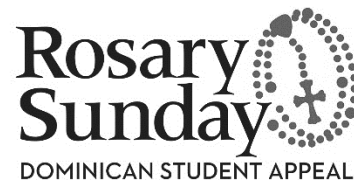
