## CANDLEMAS DAY

On Candlemas Day, Thursday, February 2 at 7 PM, the women of Cantores in Ecclesia will sing Josef Gabriel Rheinberger's *Missa* in g, Op. 187, for the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which is perhaps the most ancient of all feasts of the Blessed Virgin, for we find it established at Jerusalem in the fourth century. The words of Simeon's Canticle *Lumen ad revelationem gentium* have given rise to the institution of a procession with lighted candles, which symbolize Christ the spiritual light. The prayer of the blessing of candles and the antiphons of the procession make this rite one of the most magnificent of the whole year.

## SEXAGESIMA SUNDAY

On Sexagesima Sunday, February 19, at 11 AM, James O'Donnell, Organist and Master of the Choristers of Westminster Abbey, will conduct the boys, girls and adults in a liturgical performance of Frank Martin's *Mass for Double Choir a cappella*. Mr. O'Donnell and the Choir of Westminster Cathedral won the Gramophone 'Record of the Year' award for their Hyperion recording of this Mass in 1998. It is certainly a great honor to welcome James O'Donnell as guest director of Cantores in Ecclesia, and we hope that many of our friends and benefactors will be able to attend this special Mass leading up to Lent.
