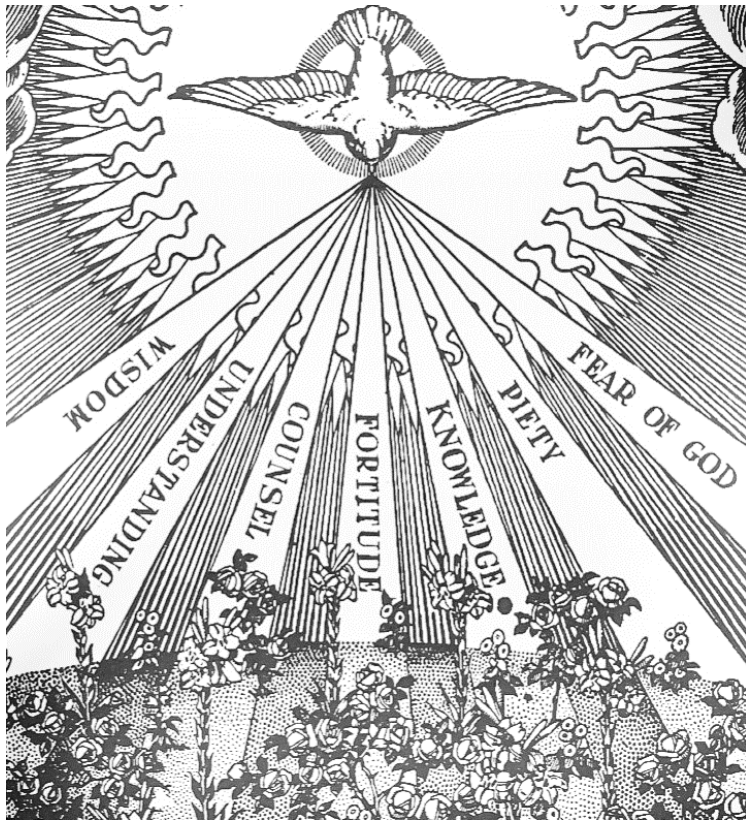

**THIS COMING THURSDAY**, May 25, at 7 PM, we will observe the traditional date of the Feast of the Ascension, according to the Dominican Rite. The other Masses this day will be on the Thursday of the sixth week after Easter. ON THURSDAY, forty days after our Lord's resurrection, still in the Paschal cycle, is kept the anniversary of the day that marked the end of his visible reign on earth. ON SUNDAY, because of the decision made by the Bishops of our region, the Feast will also be observed at all Masses, except for the 11 AM Mass, which will be celebrated according the Dominican calendar. Therefore Sunday, not Thursday, is the Holy Day of Obligation. We hope that many of our parishioners will be free to attend Mass on Thursday evening. - Fr. Vincent
