OUR LADY OF LOURDES GROTTO & MORE

While the destruction of the image of our Lady was unfortunate, this does provide us with the opportunity to provide a larger more beautiful image of our Lady and to restore a sculpture of St. Bernadette with the water feature. To protect the shrine we will construct a functional, but tasteful black wrought iron fence after the style of the original grotto in France. That our Lady again might be a sign of hope in mid-Portland, we do need donations large and small! We will be accepting gifts for this project and I will be taking a few collections. Look toward the future, we have other restorative projects in mind including: creating images of the mysteries of the Rosary on the blank northern external wall of the church, restoring the side altars to liturgical use, moving the tabernacle and altar together to create one unit, restoring the proper number of altar steps, restoring the altar rail gates, adding some gold leaf and bronze to the Stations of the Cross and angels in the church, and making a mold of the original parish statue of St. Dominic currently held at Columbia Gorge Interpretive Center in Stevenson, WA. As previous generations left us a monument of prayer, please consider helping us continue that work of love which makes our beloved parish church an even more beautiful shrine of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary!

THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI was granted to the Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264 as a feast of the sacred *Body of Christ* on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. This feast rapidly increased in importance as the piety of the later Middle Ages found in it an opportunity for an imposing manifestation of faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. This special feast was instituted in honor of the Sacrament of Sacraments. The Office and Mass were composed by St. Thomas Aquinas, O.P., and it is with theological precision and tender piety and poetic skill that St. Thomas produces one of the most exquisitely beautiful texts of the Catholic liturgy. This is particularly evident in his Sequence *Lauda Sion*, with its dogmatic accuracy, its sublime ideas, the variety of its rhymes, and the perfection of its rhythm. Devotion to the Holy Eucharist could hardly have been expressed with greater fervor or in a more magnificent form. ON THURSDAY, June 15, at 7:00 PM, a Solemn High Mass for the Feast of Corpus Christi will be celebrated according to the Dominican Rite. After Mass, a Solemn Procession in honor of the Holy Eucharist will follow. Regarding this Procession, we remember how the Israelites revered the Ark of the Covenant, which was the Presence of God among them. When they carried on their victorious cloud of incense, accompanied by the sound of musical instruments and of the songs and shouts of the multitude. As Christians, we have a treasure far more precious. In our Eucharistic pageantry for the Feast of Corpus Christi, let us feel a holy pride in forming Christ's escort and extolling his triumphs for he is in our midst. CANTORES IN ECCLESIA will sing the Corpus Christi Proper from William Byrd's *Gradualia* (1605). The choir will also sing Byrd's setting of *O salutaris hostia* and the *Pange lingua gloriosi* for the Eucharistic Procession and Byrd's *Ave Verum corpus*, as the final 'prayer to the Blessed Sacrament.' On Sunday, June 18, at all Masses except for the 11:00, the Feast of Corpus Christi will be observed according to the *Novus Ordo*.
