THE FEAST OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL will be celebrated on Thursday, June 29, at 7 AM, 12 PM and 7 PM. The evening Mass will be celebrated according to the Dominican Rite. The feast has been celebrated in Rome since the 3rd century. It was the first feast to be included in the sanctoral cycle, since it came into being well before Christmas and the feast of the Virgin Mary. The theme of the Mass is that of the Rock. Peter is the Rock upon which the Church is built, and communion with him makes us the living stones of the churchly edifice built upon the foundation laid in Peter. Appropriately enough, at the evening Mass, Cantores in Ecclesia will perform Palestrina's *Missa Tu es Petrus*, based on his own motet, published in 1572. The text of the motet is "Thou art Peter, and upon this Rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it: and I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven." A wine and cheese reception will follow the Mass in Siena Hall.
