FEAST OF THE PURIFICATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY (CANDLEMAS DAY)

Friday, February 2, 7:00 PM

On Candlemas Day, Friday, February 2 at 7 PM, the women of Cantores in Ecclesia will sing Josef Gabriel Rheinberger's *Missa in g*, Op. 187, for the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which is perhaps the most ancient of all feasts of the Blessed Virgin, for we find it established at Jerusalem in the fourth century. The words of Simeon's Canticle *Lumen ad revelationem gentium* have given rise to the institution of a procession with lighted candles, which symbolize Christ the spiritual light. The prayer of the blessing of candles and the antiphons of the procession make this rite one of the most magnificent of the whole year.

On Ash Wednesday, February 14, Mass will be celebrated according to the Dominican Rite at 7:00 PM. Please note that Mass will begin with the blessing and distribution of ashes.
